- The normal school day is based on 8.30am to 3.30pm.
- Half days are based on 8.30am to 11.30am or 12.30pm to 3.30pm.
- Extended mornings is 7.30am – 1.00pm. Extended afternoon 1.00pm. – 6.30pm.
- 3 to 4 years may attend 5 half days per week, or on certain days by arrangement.
- The nursery education grant is payable for 6 terms when a child is 3 and 4 years old.
- This is refunded to parents termly.
- There is a 10% discount for the second and subsequent children.
- All fees are exclusive of insurance (£7.00 per term) and meals.

The concessionary all year round package is based on 50 weeks per year (closing for one week at Christmas and statutory holidays only) and 7.30am to 6.30pm.

Paid in 3 instalments 1/3 of annual fee termly or 12 equal monthly payments by standing order. We also accept childcare tax vouchers.

If a normal school package is chosen or extra hours are required then these will be charged at £7.00 per hour for a (taught session or Prep) and a rate of £5.95 per hour for leisure (before and after school or holidays). No discount will be given for sessions not attended or meals not taken.

Please note: If a child is staying between 6.30 p.m – 7.30 p.m. The flexi-boarding fee applies.

We are able to provide you with an attendance package tailored to suit your individual needs. We should be pleased to discuss this and offer you fees accordingly.

All fees, including meals, are payable for each term in advance. The tuition fees include exercise books and most text books, stationery and swimming lessons. A termly fee is charged for personal text books such as the Bond books, Latin and French Books.

- A term's notice, in writing, is required for the withdrawal of a pupil from the School or Nursery. Such notice to be received not later than the first day of the term at the end of which the pupil has to be withdrawn. In the case of all-the-year-round attendance, this termly notice still applies.
- If after Registration, following the Acceptance Agreement being signed, your child fails to start school or nursery at the date agreed upon i.e. full-time or part-time, then the payment of that term's fees is payable. No allowances will be given for non-attendance once the Acceptance Agreement has been signed.
- In default, payment must be made of the full fee for the following term.

- No reduction of fees is made in the case of absence for illness, holidays, or any other cause as the expenses of carrying on the school and maintaining its efficiency are not in any reduced by the temporary absence of pupils.
- There are schemes of insurance for school fees which may be arranged individually and the attention of parents is drawn to this for their protection.
- The fees structure is reviewed annually, usually in line with salary inflation and current inflation rates generally.
- These conditions are clearly stated in the Acceptance Agreement.
